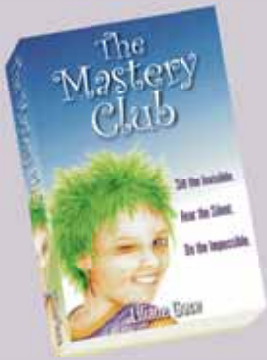


"Move over Harry, there's a new wizard in town..."

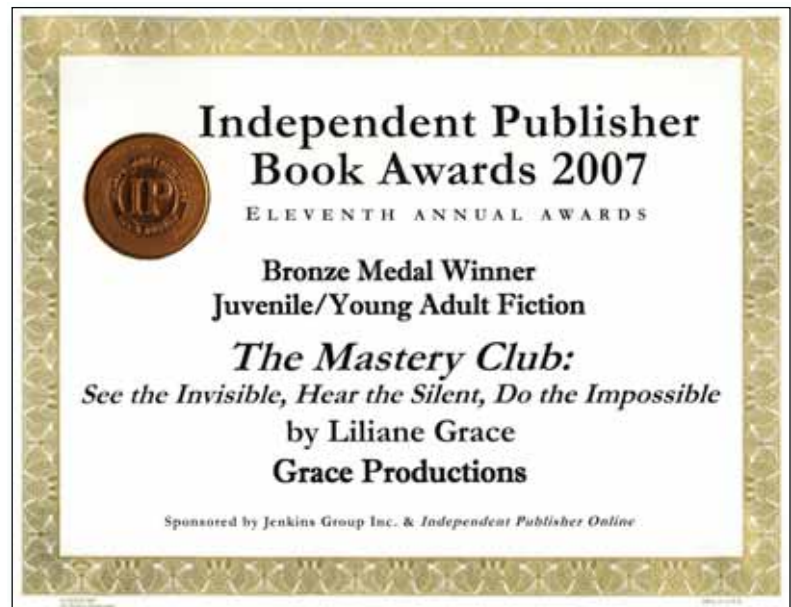

A Mastery Club Tip

Remember that how we FEEL is critical, because it's our feelings that attract experiences to us.

So try out this tip from Michael Losier, a teacher of the Law of Attraction: Whenever you find yourself dwelling on what you DON'T want in your life, and finding that your feelings are spiralling down in response, ask yourself: "SO... WHAT **DO** I WANT?" As soon as you start to dwell on what YOU DO WANT, your feelings, your emotional vibration, will rise. You can do this with others too. If you have someone around you getting stuck on what isn't working, ask them: "SO... WHAT **DO** YOU WANT?" And encourage them to list some of the qualities or results they want. That will immediately help them (and you) to feel even better.
